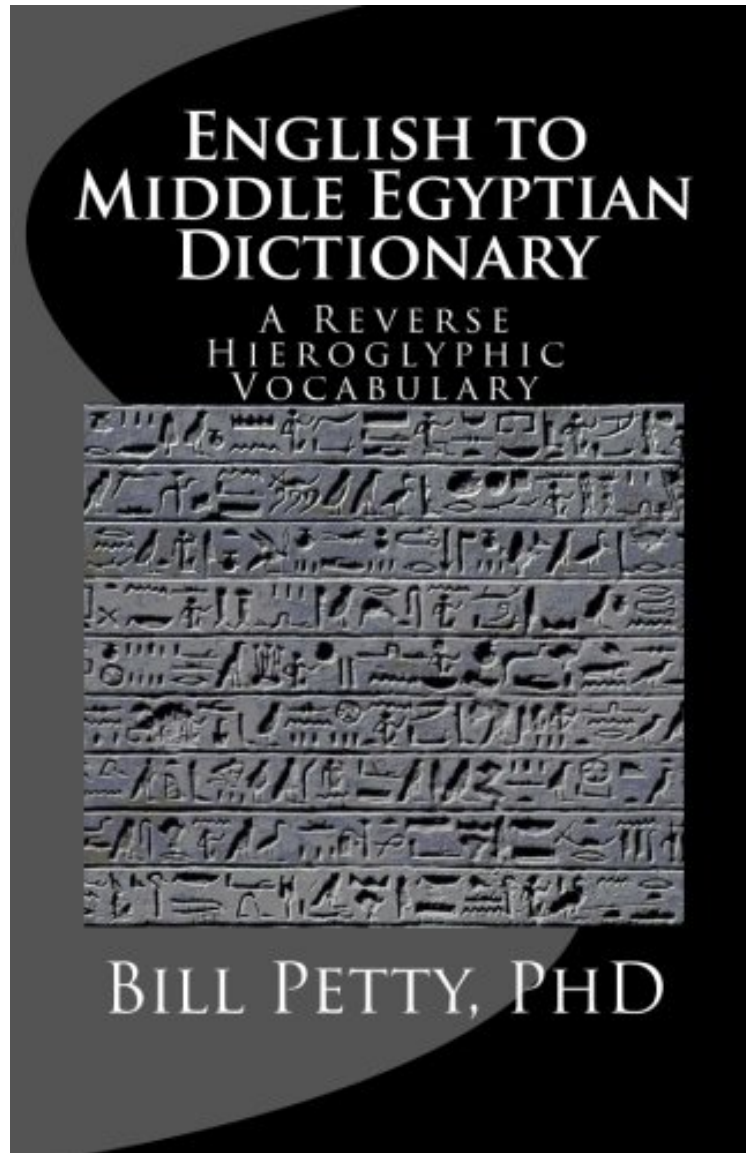

His earlier pair of books, "Hieroglyphic Sign List" and "Hieroglyphic Dictionary" were indispensable resources when I commenced my study a few years ago. Recently, Bill has added three more titles patterned on the first so that the student can cross-refer seamlessly between them. The new books, "Egyptian Glyphary", "The Names of the Kings of Egypt" and "English to Middle Egyptian Dictionary" are sufficiently comprehensive, yet simple and usable to be the primary references which I use. In addition, Petty's "Understanding Hieroglyphic Inscriptions" is a superb textbook arranged in the same style. This is the most comprehensive English to Middle Egyptian dictionary available, with about 8,000 entries, including almost all of the most common English words in use. It compares very favorably with Gardiner's English-Egyptian Vocabulary and Nichols' book, each containing only about 2,000 entries. This is the fifth book in Museum Tours "The Essentials" series, along with Hieroglyphic Dictionary, Hieroglyph Sign List, Egyptian Glyphary and The Names of the Kings of Egypt.
