However, when you are looking at a word in the Hebrew and then you look at it in the English, and you are concerned about the translation, The Englishman's Concordance to the Hebrew Old Testament allows you to see that verb in that particular stem everywhere it occurs in the Old Testament. This is an indispensable tool for pastors who refer back to the original languages, for exegetes and commentators, and for Hebrew students. I rated this 4 stars rather than 5 for two reasons: the binding of my book was lousy (I have the hardbound version; sometimes a paperback binding can be more durable) and this is based upon the KJV, which is a very accurate and literary translation of the Bible, but anachronistic. Since the author has been dead for 150 years, I don't think he is going to revise this.
