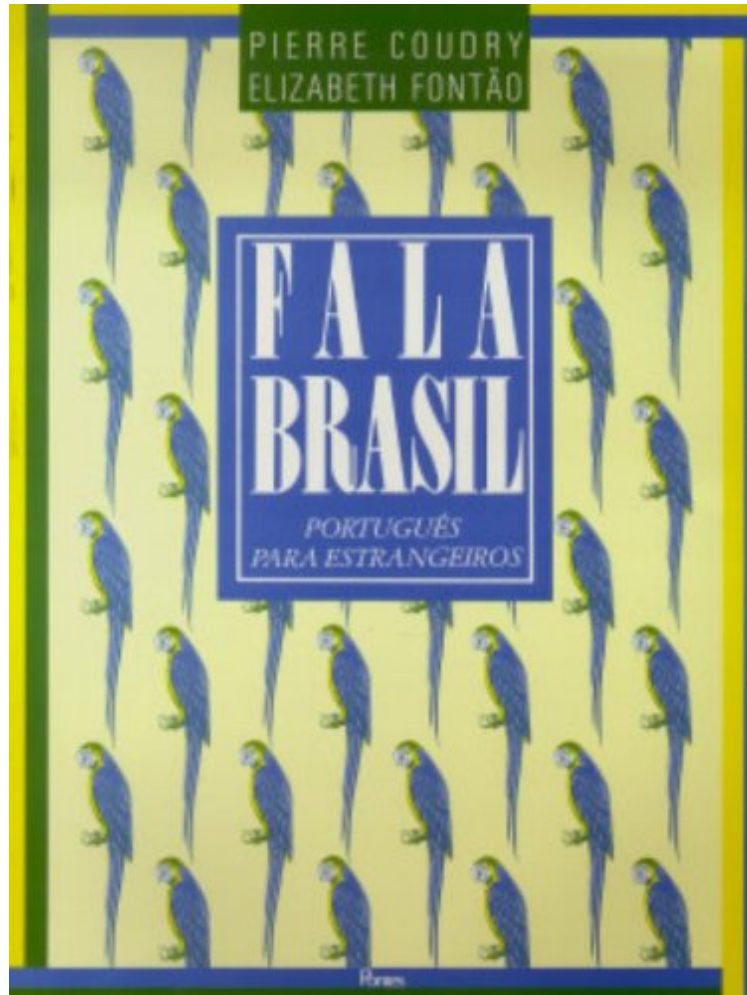

In fact, in studying at the language school founded by Pierre Coudry's mother, and she was instrumental in writing this book. Pierre is one of my teachers. I had studied Spanish in college, and this textbook is so much better than my

college text book. Fala Brasil is not a large textbook, but it is fairly complete. The thinness of the book is one of its greatest assets because it isn't difficult to carry around. One of my teachers has used other text books in the past, and she said this one is the best she's seen for grammar. The exercise book is decent, but we do supplement it with other books and exercises. This book is particularly good for one-on-one instruction. Don't expect to cover many pages in any one class period, because an hour or more can be spent on any one page in the book. The book also covers idioms and other important phrases throughout the book. It also introduces the student to many facets of Brazilian culture. I would recommend this book to anyone!
