Some good leads, but not as many as I had hopedBy eemiller82The book contains information about scholarships, fellowships, and grants-in-aid for veterans, military personnel, and family members. I was considering buying the book, but I checked it out first because \$40 is a little steep.After looking through all of the scholarships, fellowships, and grants available to veterans (several hundred), I only found two new leads that MIGHT apply to my situation. (Most of the financial aid opportunities have very specific criteria--only open to residents of a particular state, only open to students pursuing a particular major, or only servicemen and women who served in a particular branch of the military.)NOTE: I did not investigate the financial aid opportunities for military personnel and family members, so I

can not give an evaluation of them. One small criticism: There appears to be a lot of redundancy between the scholarships and fellowships. UPDATE: It's been a month, and the two leads that I found didn't yield any results. Bottom Line - This may be helpful to you, but it wasn't particularly helpful to me. I'm glad I only checked it out of the library instead of paying \$40 for it.
