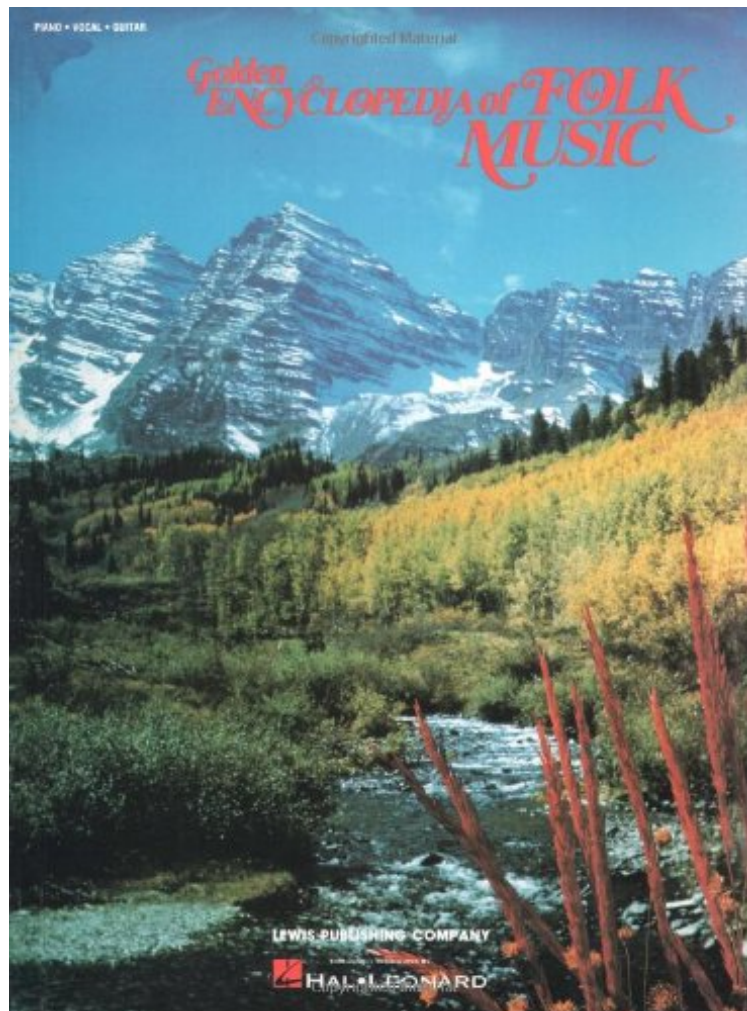

traditional folk songs in a dozen categories, each with sheet music and chords. The standard sing-along songs are here with generally easy renditions, and with quite a few many singers won't know. Many songs are illustrated with whimsical line drawings as well. This is a basic go-to reference that you will often turn to. Because of its bulkiness, my first recommendation would be to take it to a print shop to be spirally bound, so that the pages lie flat.
