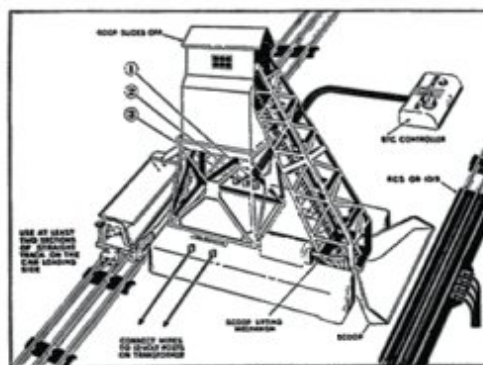


Figure 1—Lionel No. 97 Coal Elevator in Layout showing Transformer and Controller Connections.

If that helps you knowing Lionel's exact part number and you have a boat-load of accessories then this is the book for you. It is NOT a repair manual. The book is comprised of "Service Bulletins" that may inform the (then) repair shop how to retro-fit a new smoke unit for the bulb type...things of that ilk if you get me. Most of the bulletins show you things like where to oil your locomotive and other minor explanations. Do NOT expect wiring diagrams for specific locomotives. There are a few exploded diagrams for "Bild-A-LoCo's" and diagrams for a ton of miscellaneous accessories but, frankly, not much about trains and nothing regarding repairs. There is also the entire assembly instructions for the 700E kit Hudson. I'm not entirely

sorry I bought this book...It really isn't much help but it's nice that I am building a small library of Lionel train related books and this one fits as far as that goes. Not nearly as big a disappointment as Greenberg's Prewar Lionel Repair and Operating Manual. You may want to think twice about dropping any serious coin on that one. And so in parting, I too remain on the quest for the ever elusive "complete prewar Lionel repair manual" loaded with every wiring diagram for every locomotive. Good luck and happy hunting.
