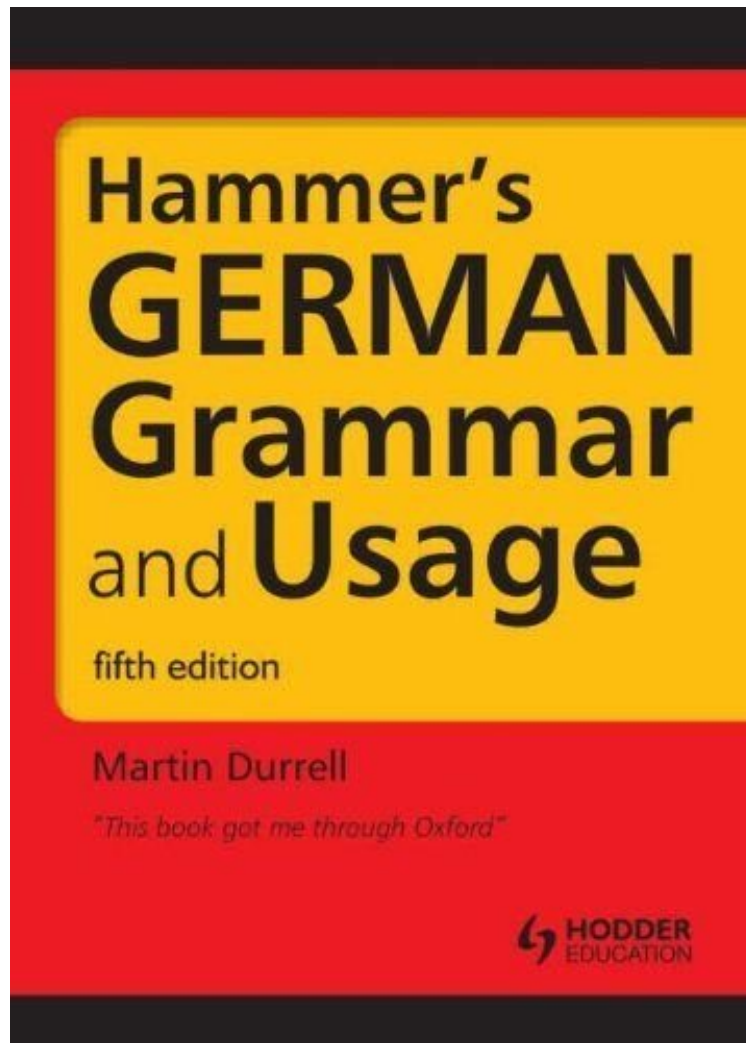

In other words, it is impossible to learn the hundreds of grammatical rules and colloquialisms and modern-day usages that are contained in this book, even if you ARE a native speaker! My only quarrel with the book is that it sometimes gives examples by using German sentences but then does not translate the sentence into English, which defeats the
