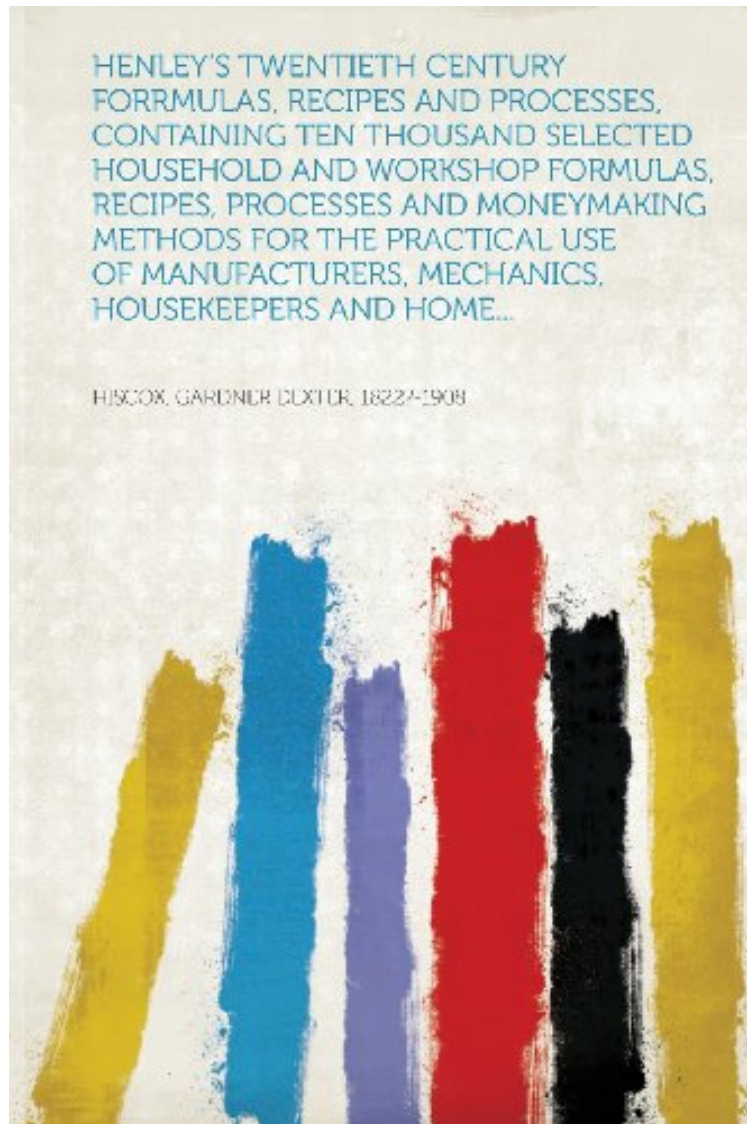

Sometimes there are ingredient terms no longer used, but you can usually find the modern name of such or a replacement/substitute with a simple Wikipedia search.
