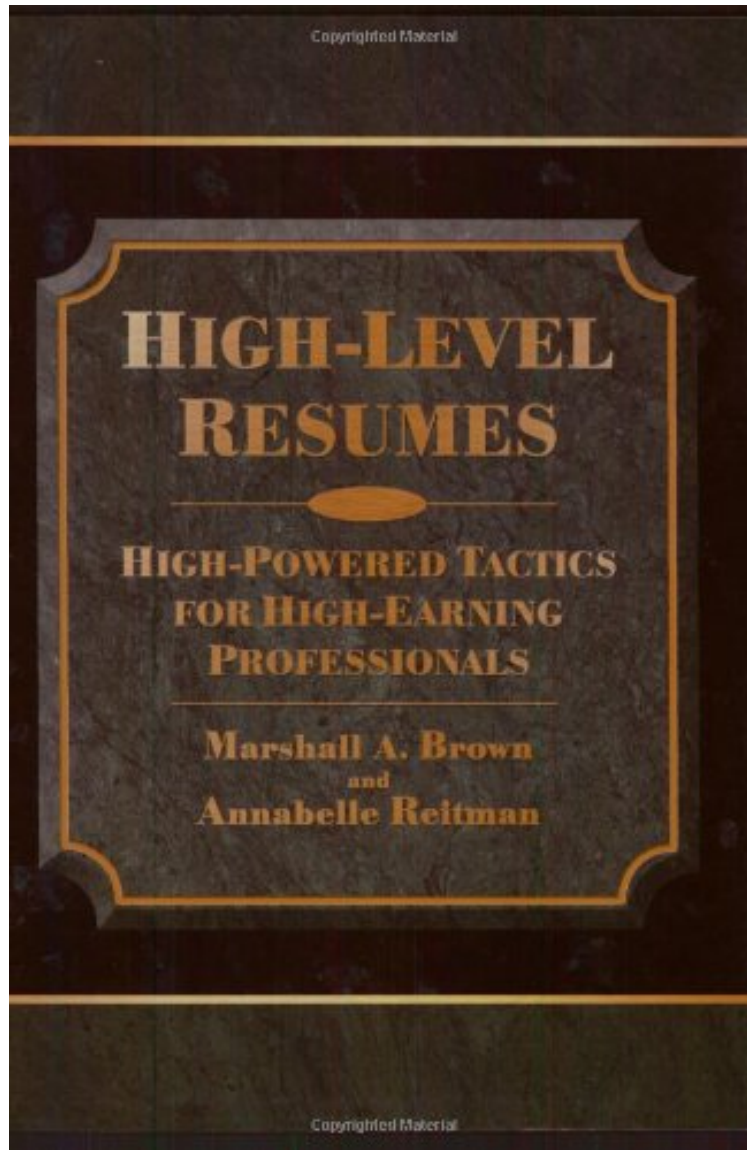

I was disappointed for three main reasons: 1) most of the resumes were written in very traditional formats; nothing clever or innovative 2) the same style seems to be used over and over...each one looks like a template 3) my biggest complaint is the lack of a resume index. There are 37 resume examples but no where in this book can you find out which page relates to healthcare, IT or manufacturing. Therefore, you have to flip through every single resume to find the industry or position you are seeking. Not user-friendly at all! I finally took the time to categorize each resume myself, print out my own index and tape it inside the book cover. However, I haven't really even used this book as a reference...I really don't recommend this one at all. 1 of 1 people found the following review helpful. *Craft Your Story* By Tom K. This book emphasizes the need to determine exactly what image and story will connect you with your target job. It provides current, relevant, well-formatted examples for executives. The work-sheets and steps are adequate, but not overly insightful. This is a book that is worth browsing from the library to find examples that resonate. Reading the rationale for the story approach is worthwhile.
