Papinot was originally published in 1910 when the Emperor Meiji ruled, a united Korea was part of Japan, and the regnal era name Showa referred to a 14th century emperor rather than the 20th century Emperor Hirohito. The book is thus outdated in that it does not include recent information, but it nonetheless remains a resource of great merit, one that contributed significantly to my research for "Symbols of Japan: Thematic Motifs in Art and Design."The heart of the book is its alphabetized 765 pages of dictionary definitions of people, places, ceremonials, and bureaucratic matters. Japanese ideographs appear solely in these pages to render the name of the entry, but the book does assume that its user is searching against a romanized Japanese term. For example, page 560 has an entry for "Shaku-i shi-ju-hachi kai" which means the 48 ranks of nobles and officials system established in 685, but it provides no way of locating this material should the user be familiar only with an English-language descriptor. In addition to these A-to-Z entries, Papinot has included numerous appendices. Among these are identifications of important foreigners; tables of classical province, department and
