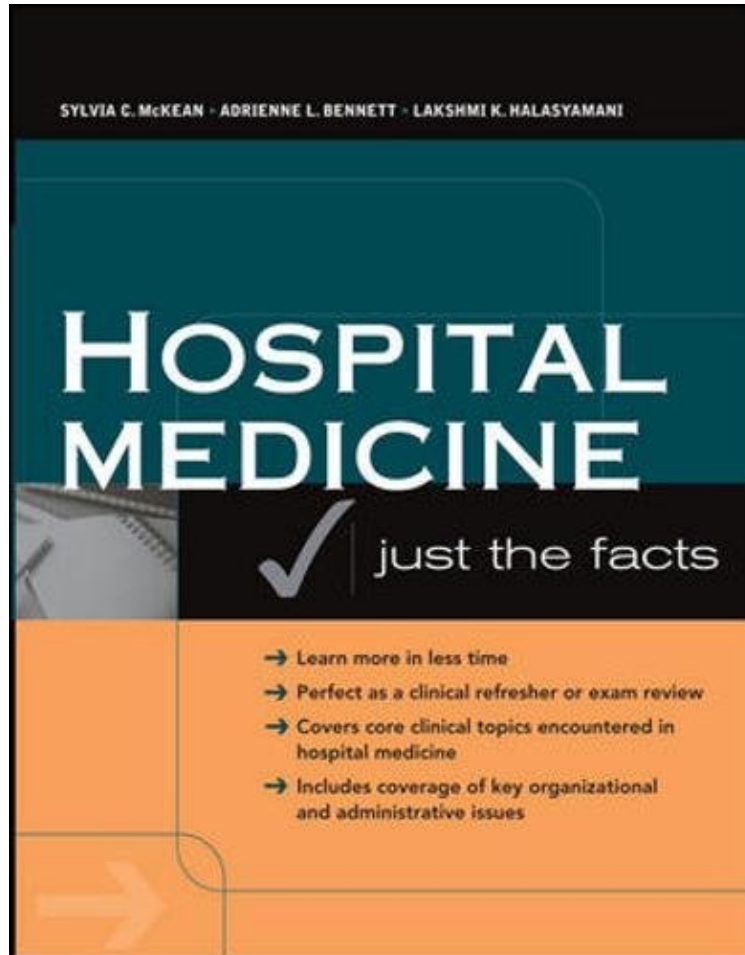

The book is a first edition and I noted several typos. HOSPITAL MEDICINE (2005) and COMPREHENSIVE HOSPITAL MEDICINE (2007) are much more detailed books. As a hospitalist, I own all three of these books, so I speak from first hand experience. If you can only get one and you plan to buy this year, I recommend COMPREHENSIVE HOSPITAL MEDICINE.
