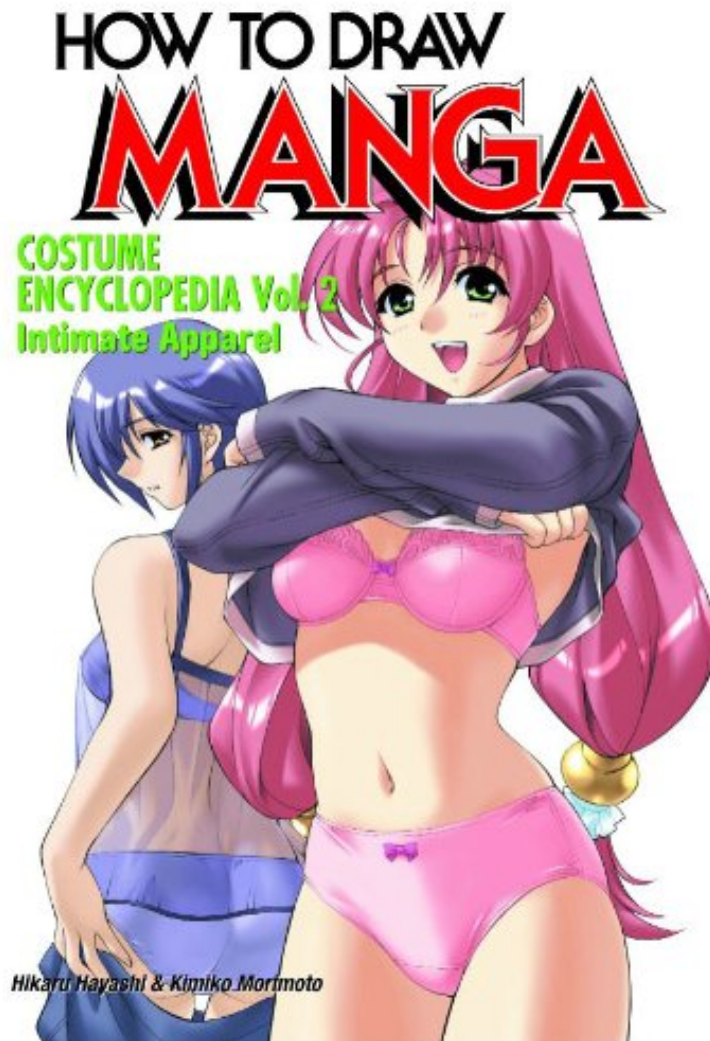

It had an amazing amount of different selections of intimate apparel (spelling?), and it was really interesting. There was an entire section on past intimate apparel that was really helpful, and the amount of different bras and panties was amazing. Half cup bras, 3/4 cup bras, full bras, strapless bras, tummy bras, etc. Then there was lacing for the bras. Then there is a whole section on how to draw all of these things.
