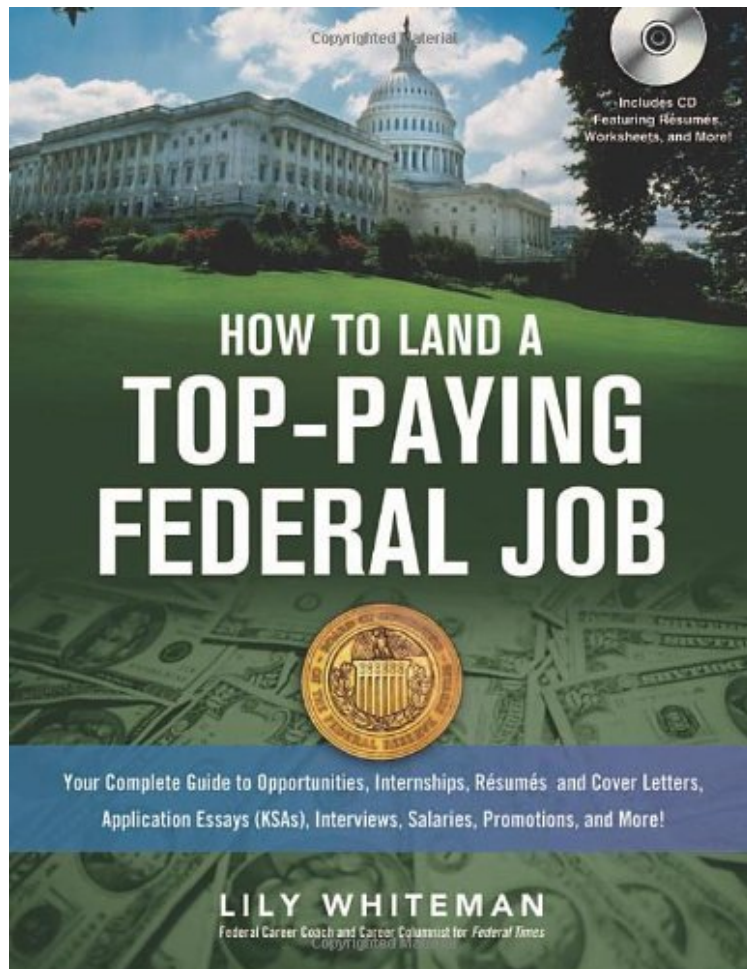

Her book explodes the many myths about Federal government employment, and explains in a straightforward manner (1) how to research great Federal work opportunities, (2) how to land great Federal jobs, (3) how to negotiate Federal job offers once received, and (4) how to thrive in the Federal government when working there. The book is well-written, easy to understand, and full of great examples and practical, easy to implement advice. The section on negotiating Federal job offers is especially useful.
