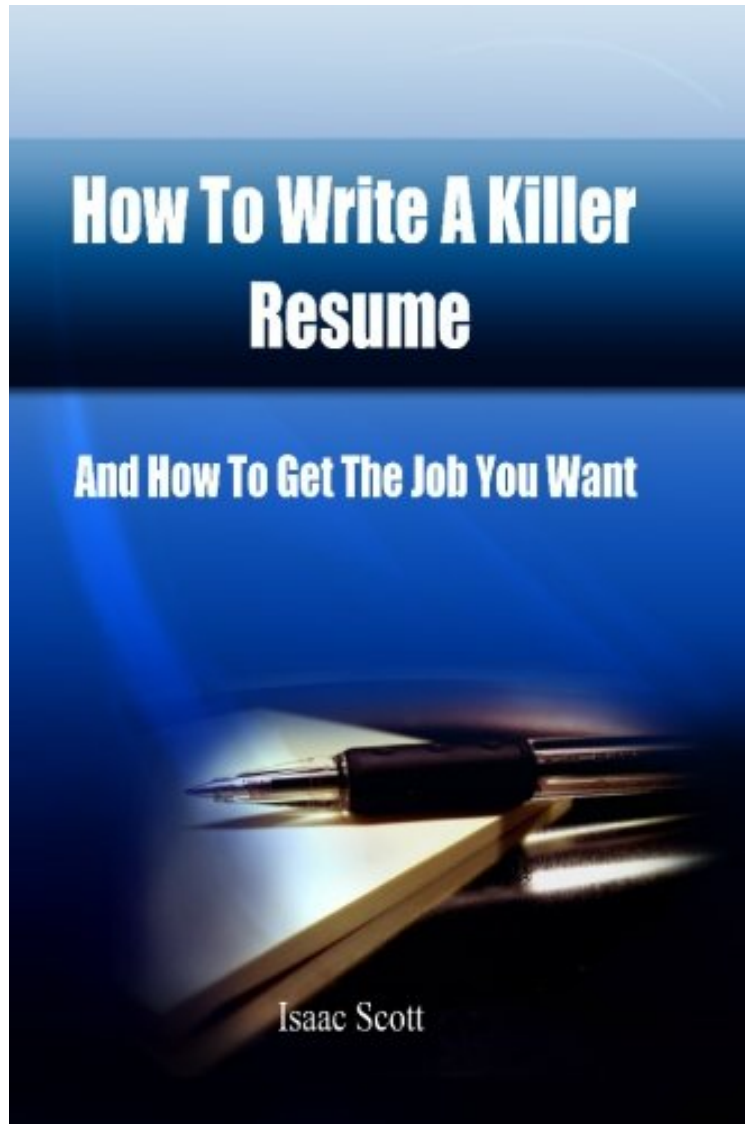

It doesn't do much of anything but give some (emphasis on some) helpful hints. It is not comprehensive by any means, and provides no examples. The author just

casually says stuff. What this book is good for is as an example of spelling, grammar and punctuation miscues. That's where it's true value is. The author expects to gain credibility when messing up the difference between to and too? See that question mark? There are many interrogative sentences that end with a period instead of question marks. I'm not being the grammar police, but all these mistakes make for awkward, unprofessional reading. If anyone had bothered to proof-read this book it would have been way better. As it stands, I'm going to make my own edits on this book and mail it to the publisher. The book has absolutely no value sitting on my bookshelf or desk. Example sentences: From page 8: "If you are giving a document to someone who will make such important assumptions about, that effect your very livelihood-Why use cheap printer paper. I recommend...." Page 9: "Also consider how the condition of the envelope and cover letter." That is an actual sentence. And that is using the definition of sentence loosely.
