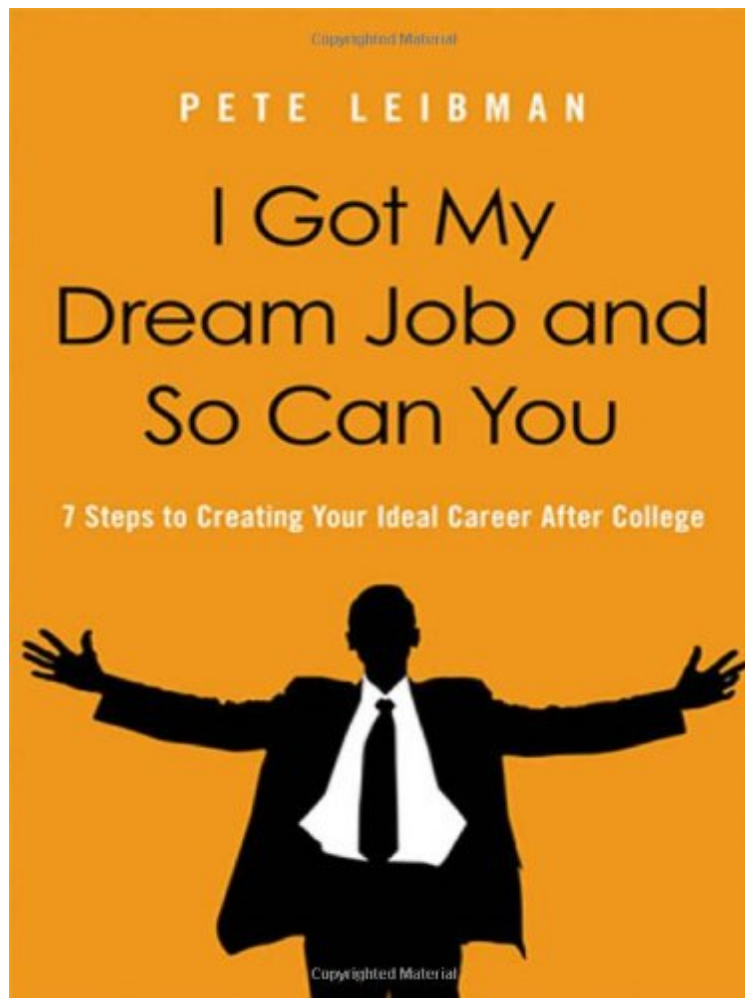

The advice about networking and advice appointments in particular, is extremely difficult, and in my experience and the experience of those around me, rarely fruitful in actually finding a job.
